Services Provided: DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES: Provides free day and evening classes to improve basic skills and/or prepare for the GED® test. Free childcare for qualifying students is available while attending class at the Scott Bibb Center. Free English as a Second Language instruction; Project READ provides free one-on-one tutoring; family education; i-Pathways (online GED® instruction). Adult Education now offers multiple modes of instruction such as face-to-face, online or a hybrid model called BlendFlex which allows students to move between live virtual instruction and face-to-face instruction. The LCCC Adult Education Division encourages its students to transition to college and offers special programs that include Building Futures YouthBuild, AmeriCorps and transition services to support participants entering post-secondary education. LCCC Adult Education Department offers multiple career pathways through YouthBuild which include: computer careers, construction, health sciences, TDL (transportation/distribution/logistics) warehousing and welding.
